 - Activity: Add a natural bio and backlink to your draft article

- Why guest posting isn’t just one-time—it’s about relationships
 - Real-life example: Becoming a regular contributor to a popular tech site
 - How to follow up politely and thank editors
 - Tips for being invited back for more opportunities
 - Activity: Draft a “thank you” email to an editor after posting
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Module 7: Promoting Your Published Guest Posts

- How to get more eyes on your published articles
 - Real-life example: Sharing a guest post on LinkedIn and growing connections
 - Using social media, email lists, and groups to share your work
 - Tagging and thanking the host blog for extra exposure
 - Activity: Create a social media promotion plan for your guest post
