Module 1: Introduction to Vue.js

- What is Vue.js and why developers love it
 - Real-life example: Instantly updating a shopping cart total
 - How Vue.js makes building dynamic websites simpler
 - The idea of "reactive" web pages
 - Activity: Set up your first basic Vue app
-

Module 2: Vue Instance and Data Binding

- What is the Vue instance and how it controls the page
 - Real-life example: Changing your profile name live as you type
 - How to bind data using `{{ }}` (double curly braces)
 - Introduction to `data`, `methods`, and `mounted`
 - Activity: Create a simple app that updates a greeting dynamically

Module 3: Handling Events in Vue

- How to capture clicks, inputs, and form submissions
 - Real-life example: Clicking a "Like" button and counting likes
 - Using `v-on` and event listeners
 - Handling user interaction easily
 - Activity: Make a button that updates a message when clicked
-

Module 4: Conditional Rendering and Loops

- Showing, hiding, and looping through items dynamically
- Real-life example: Displaying a to-do list that updates live

- Using `v-if`, `v-else`, and `v-for`
 - How to manage lists and conditions smartly
 - Activity: Build a list of your favorite books and show/hide it

Module 5: Components in Vue

- What are components and why they are important
 - Real-life example: Reusing the same "card" layout for products
 - Creating and using simple Vue components
 - Passing data with props
 - Activity: Create a reusable card component for a profile
-

Module 6: Forms and Two-Way Binding

- Making smart forms with `v-model`
 - Real-life example: Filling a feedback form that updates live
 - Binding inputs, checkboxes, and select dropdowns
 - Validating and managing form data
 - Activity: Create a live signup form with name and email fields
-

Module 7: Building a Small App with Vue.js

- Combine templates, components, and data into a working app
 - Real-life example: A simple notes app with add/delete functionality
 - Structuring your Vue project folders
 - Testing and fixing small bugs
 - Activity: Build and style your own mini app
-

Module 8: Final Project – Your First Vue Web App

- Plan and develop a complete mini Vue.js project
 - Real-life idea: A mini blog or product showcase app
 - Organizing components, styling, and deploying
 - Activity: Present your final Vue.js project to classmates or friends
