Google Bard Course Outline

Module 1: What is Google Bard?

- Simple definition: Bard is Google's AI that talks and answers questions
- How it's different from regular search engines
- Real-life example: Asking Bard to help plan a birthday party
- Activity: Ask Bard a question and compare its answer with Google Search

Module 2: How Google Bard Works

- Based on a language model called PaLM
- Understands, processes, and responds like a helpful human
- Real-life example: Like having a smart assistant always ready
- Activity: Match simple tasks to Bard responses

Module 3: Using Bard for Everyday Help

- Writing, brainstorming, summarizing, and translating
- Research help and idea generation for students
- Real-life example: Bard writes a poem or essay introduction
- Activity: Ask Bard to write a paragraph in your own words

Module 4: Bard in School, Work & Business

- Teachers and students using Bard for assignments
- Businesses using Bard for emails and customer replies
- Real-life example: Creating a job description with Bard
- Activity: Create a list of 3 things Bard could help you with at school or work

Module 5: Crafting Great Prompts for Bard

- What is a prompt and why it matters
- Writing clear, detailed, and helpful instructions
- Real-life example: Asking "Explain climate change to a 10-year-old"
- Activity: Rewrite 2 weak prompts into better ones

Module 6: Knowing Bard's Limits

- Not always perfect or up to date
- Doesn't browse the internet in real-time
- Real-life example: Bard gives an outdated movie fact
- Activity: Identify and fix a sample Bard error

Module 7: Real-World Bard Uses

- Students, writers, marketers, and developers using Bard
- Creative tasks: songwriting, storytelling, planning
- Real-life example: Bard helps plan a YouTube content calendar
- Activity: Design your own Bard-powered project idea

Module 8: The Future of Bard & AI Tools

- Where Bard and other AI tools are going
- Careers: AI Researcher, Data Analyst, Prompt Engineer
- Skills to grow: writing, critical thinking, ethical use
- Activity: Imagine the perfect AI tool of the future and draw or describe it
